

Cookie Policy

Policy Statement

European Electronique have a responsibility as a Data Controller and are committed to protecting you and any data that we collect about you online. Our Policy informs you how our website uses cookies and why. As data controller we will ask you to consent to our use of cookies when you first visit our website. By visiting our website, you agree that we can place cookies on your device. We also reserve the right to change our Cookies Policy. Any changes shall appear here and become effective immediately. Your continued use of our website is taken as meaning that you agree to any such changes.

What is a Cookie?

A cookie is a file containing an identifier (a string of letters and numbers) that is sent by a web server to a web browser and is stored by the browser. The identifier is then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page from the server.

Cookies may be either "persistent" cookies or "session" cookies: a persistent cookie will be stored by a web browser and will remain valid until its set expiry date, unless deleted by the user before the expiry date; a session cookie, on the other hand, will expire at the end of the user session, when the web browser is closed.

Cookies may not contain any information that personally identifies a user, but personal data that we store about you may be linked to the information stored in and obtained from cookies.

Cookies that we use

Authentication - we use cookies to identify you when you visit our website and as you navigate our website, and to help us determine if you are logged into our website.

Security - we use cookies as a security measure to protect user accounts, including preventing fraudulent use of login credentials, and to protect our website and services generally.

Analysis - we use cookies to help us to analyse the use and performance of our website and services. We use Google Analytics. Google Analytics gathers information about the use of our website by means of cookies. The information gathered is used to create reports about the use of our website. Managing Cookies

Most browsers allow you to refuse to accept cookies and to delete cookies. The methods for doing so vary from browser to browser, and from version to version. Blocking all cookies will have a negative impact upon the usability of many websites. If you block cookies, you will not be able to use all the features on our website.
